With the funds that was donated by Virbac we were able acquire 10 benches and 20 chairs to enhance their learning environment .

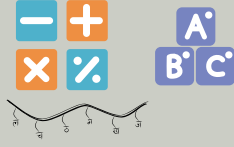

Regular meetings with parents have strengthened community involvement.



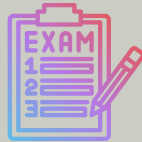
Competitions have helped them build confidence and showcase their talents.

## Plan For Next Quarter

Organize workshops on nutrition, personal hygiene, and disease prevention.



Encourage children to explore new skills such as storytelling, painting, and basic computer literacy.



Conduct sports tournaments to promote teamwork and physical fitness.



Identify and enroll more street children in the project.
