As we continue on this path, we invite you to stay with us on this journey. With your help, we can keep opening doors for many more children who deserve a chance to dream and thrive.

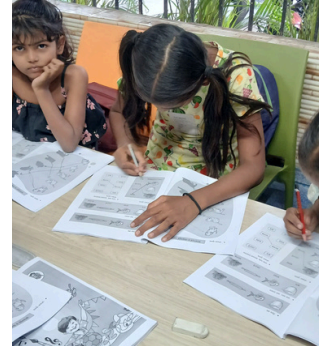

- We are committed to providing structured SSC curriculum learning mainly focusing on Primary class from 1st to 5th Class.
- From basic literacy to essential numeracy skills.



## Nutrition & Hygiene

- To ensure their physical well-being, we provide nutritious meals daily, keeping them energized and healthy.
- Hygiene education is equally important—our team regularly conducts awareness sessions on personal cleanliness, ensuring that children develop habits that will benefit them for a lifetime.



## Empowering Through Life Skills

- Our program includes interactive sessions on confidence building, problem-solving, and emotional well-being. These sessions help children become independent, resilient, and capable of making informed decisions.



## Smart Class :

Introduced Smart Classes to enhance learning for street children. This initiative integrates digital tools, interactive content, and visual learning to improve comprehension and engagement.

By using animated videos, educational apps, and real-world simulations, children grasp concepts better and actively participate in lessons.



## Documentation and Registration of students with BMC

We are overjoyed to share a significant milestone in our journey—22 children have been successfully registered in the BMC school after careful efforts in completing their documentation, and the registration process for a few more is currently underway. Watching these children, who once had no access to formal education, now proudly wearing their school uniforms and walking to school with bright smiles and eager hearts, is a moment of immense pride and joy for all of us. This transformation stands as a testament to the power of care, commitment, and collective effort.



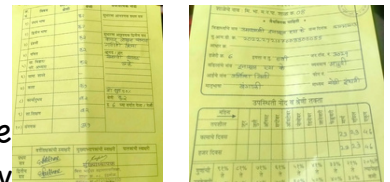
## From Despair to Determination: Umair's Journey with Project Sapno Ki Udaan

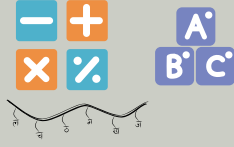
## Mind Mania: Puzzle Play Day

Documentation of the students ( Aadhar Card, Birth certificate



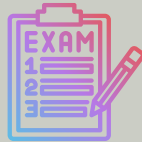
Registering with the BMC school to streamline them in normal education
