Nurturing Young Minds: Quality Education

- We are committed to providing structured SSC curriculum learning mainly focusing on Primary class from 1st to 5th Class.
- From basic literacy to essential numeracy skills.



Nutrition & Hygiene

- To ensure their physical well-being, we provide nutritious meals daily, keeping them energized and healthy.
- Hygiene education is equally important—our team regularly conducts awareness sessions on personal cleanliness, ensuring that children develop habits that will benefit them for a lifetime.



Empowering Through Life Skills

Smart Class :

Introduced Smart Classes to enhance learning for street children. This initiative integrates digital tools, interactive content, and visual learning to improve comprehension and engagement.

Supplementary Education for 6 - 10th class

Under Project Sapno ki Udaan, Rays of Life Foundation has introduced a Supplementary Education Program for students from 6th to 10th standard.

This initiative supports children from underprivileged and migrant families by providing focused academic assistance in core subjects such as Mathematics, Science, English, and Social Studies. The program emphasizes strengthening foundational concepts, regular doubt-clearing sessions, and personalized mentoring, ensuring that students not only perform better academically but also gain the confidence to pursue higher studies.

In addition to academics, the program integrates life skills training, value-based learning, and career guidance, preparing students for both examinations and future opportunities. 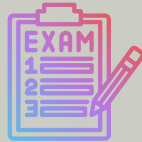
